**POINT 1-** God is the Creator and His \_\_\_\_\_ is powerful; we should worship, stay faithful, and hold onto the truth.

2. When the KJV was translated in AD \_\_\_\_\_, they used a Greek manuscript called the *Textus Receptus*.
  3. These Pharisees prioritized their man-made rules over showing compassion for the man who had been healed or \_\_\_\_\_ for the healer.
