2. Jesus is alluding to His **upcoming ascension** and making a clear statement about His \_\_\_\_\_.

**POINT 1-** Jesus emphasizes that only those whom the Father \_\_\_\_\_ the **ability** can **come** to Him, underscoring the necessity of divine grace for salvation.
